# Day 1

Saturday, June 13<sup>th</sup>

# Day 2

Sunday, June 14<sup>th</sup>

Following breakfast, we will depart from the Hotel Phillips and drive west for our first view of The Nature Conservancy's Tallgrass Prairie Preserve. At the preserve we will slowly wander the quiet backroads on the lookout for scissor-tailed flycatchers, wandering bison, grumpy badgers, and other species of wildlife. We may walk some short trails or along the roads so be prepared with suitable shoes (sneakers will do). In the afternoon we will tour the beautiful Flint Hills landscape and visit the historic four door town of Sedan, Kansas. We will return to Bartlesville in the late afternoon.

This park with its stream and small waterfalls is a perfect place to experience the diversity of plants and animals that inhabit the both the prairies and the forests. We will return to Bartlesville in the late afternoon.

We will depart for the concert site in the late afternoon and return to the hotel after 11:00 pm.
